A meeting of the Town Council of the Town of Occoquan, Va. was held in the banking room of the Bank of Occoquan, on the above date

The following Councilmen were present .

F. M. Lynn , R. S. Hall, E. E. Payne and S. H. Selecman also Mayor Gordon Leary and the Clerk.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

The matter of the salary of H. C. Slack was brought up and discussed.

A motion was made by F. M. Lynn that H. C. Slack be allowed \$20.00 for his services as Clerk. Motion was duly seconded and carried.

Letters from Mrs. Florence Lacey , H. L. Mooney, Mr. and Mrs. A. J. Petellat , M. J. Best and H. T. Selecman, complaining of bad sanitary conditions and fire hazards were read by the Clerk.

These matters were discussed at length by the Council also by H. L. Mooney E. R. Shanklin and M. J. Best who were present in person to bring the matter before the Council also A. J. Petellat.

Mayor Leary thereupon appointed R. S. Hall and F. M. Lynn to make a tour of inspection around town and report their findings as to the sanitary conditions to the Mayor and Council.

F. M. Lynn offered the following ordinance and moved its adoption. " Be It Ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Occoquan, Occoquan, Va. that all buildings constituting a fire hazard shall be condemned and torn down. A vote was taken on the adoption of said ordinance as offered the Councilmen voting as follows.

R. S. Hall Yea, S. H. Selecman, Yea, E. E. Payne yea

F. M. Lynn yea. The Mayor thereupon declared the ordinance duly adopted and instructed the Clerk of publish said ordinance by posting the same in at least one public place in the town.

The Mayor then appointed R. S. Hall, S. H. Selecman and E. E. Payne and as technical advisor H. L. Mooney , to act as an inspection committee to inspect building in the Town and report to the Council their findings.

There being no further business to come before the Council, meeting adjourned.


